

NORTH CAROLINA COUPLE OF THE YEAR VISITATION PLAQUES AND VISITATION CARDS

OBJECTIVES:

- To generate FUN between all Couples
- Encourage Chapter visitations
- Promote GWRRA in our communities

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE:

- All current NC Chapter Couples with a current GWRRA Membership

GUIDELINES:

- The North Carolina District is divided into three sections: East...Central...West. Each Plaque will be designated to its own section. The Plaque can only be given away or captured in its own section and only by Couples that are Members of Chapters in that section. Example: If you are a Couple and Member of a Chapter in the Central section you cannot capture the East or West Plaques. You cannot give away the Plaque if you are not in your respective section. A list of all the Couples and the Chapters/sections they are in will be provided to you according to your section.
- All current eligible Chapter Couples in attendance for that meeting that represent a Chapter in their specific section of North Carolina will enter their individual names or tickets for the Plaque drawing, one ticket per individual in attendance. In other words, if both halves of the Chapter Couple are in attendance, they would have one ticket each or two per Couple. If only one half of the Couple is in attendance, there would only be one name in the drawing. This is to encourage Chapter Couples to attend gatherings together. The Couple giving it away is not eligible to win unless no other current Chapter Couples are present. If there is only one Chapter Couple or one half a Chapter Couple present at the meeting, they will capture it.
- A time limit of ten (10) days has been set for giving the Plaque away. When there is a 5 week calendar month and no gatherings during that week, please take the Plaque to the last gathering of that month or the first gathering of the next month. Try to keep the Plaque moving as much as possible. Remember this is a way to have fun with friends, carrying it from Chapter to Chapter. If you win the Plaque and cannot carry it to another Chapter gathering in the allowed time, then you should sign the sheet on the back and give it to someone else (preferably another Chapter Couple) to carry to a gathering for you. You will still receive credit for capturing it. Always remember, you are making lifelong friends.
- Before the end of the gathering, the winning Chapter Couple should announce when and where they will be taking the Plaque for the next drawing.
- The winning Chapter Couple is responsible for notifying, as soon as possible, North Carolina District Couple Of The Year, and the other Chapter Couples within their section as to where they will be taking the Plaque. Send an e-mail to the Google group e-mail address for your respective section. When you capture the Plaque, use this e-mail to pass the information along. an email address. The key phrase is "communicate as soon as possible".
- If there are 2 or more meetings on the same day, the plaque can move within the same day if it is feasibly possible to contact all the couples in your area by phone and let them know where it is going.
- After winning the Plaque, write your name, date you received it, the number of Couples in attendance and where you are taking it (such as NC-?) on the plaque recipient sheets provided. You are responsible for ensuring your information has been documented correctly.
- The Plaque winner should be drawn within 5 minutes of the start of the gathering. It is your responsibility to let the Chapter Director know that you have the Plaque, and you are responsible for the drawing.
- The final day for the Plaques to be given away will be the last day of November. Plaques must be turned in to District Membership Enhancement Program Coordinator OR the Assistant District Directors at Gifts on Cycles.

NORTH CAROLINA COUPLE OF THE YEAR VISITATION PLAQUES AND VISITATION CARDS (cont.)

VISITATION BY CHAPTER COUPLES:

- There will also be Chapter Visitation cards for Couples only. These are to be signed and dated by each North Carolina Chapter Director and you must stay until the end of each meeting to qualify for a signature. No Chapter can be counted twice until you visit all North Carolina Chapters. Once you accomplish that, you can start getting signatures again for the second round. Extra cards will be available from District Membership Enhancement Coordinator. There will be a cash award for the Couple or half Couple that visits the most NORTH CAROLINA Chapters. (Chapters outside North Carolina will not count.) Get all the Chapters you can, and you just may win.
- The visitation contest will run through the end of November, same as the plaques. All couples visitation cards must be turned in to the District Membership Enhancement Program Coordinator or the Assistant District Director at Gifts on Cycles.

REWARDS:

- All three Couples Plaques will be retired and given away at the Operations Meeting in January, one for each area. Your name will be entered into a drawing one time for every time that you signed the Plaque throughout the year.
- There will be two fifty dollar (\$50) cash drawings. All Chapter Couples that participated in the program throughout the year are eligible for the drawings.
- There will be a Certificate and a one hundred dollar (\$100) award for the Couple with the most NC Chapter visits. In case of a tie, there will be a drawing. Couples do not need to be present to win any of the rewards.
